Designing Women’s Leadership: Partnership-based Innovation

Partnership occurs when leaders and those they lead are in a thriving state. Domination causes a survival state, where breakthroughs are non-existent. Applying the lens of the partnership and domination systems makes the invisible visible—and shows that the cultural construction of the roles and relations of the female and male halves of humanity is not “just a women’s issue” but central to the ongoing viability of business.
